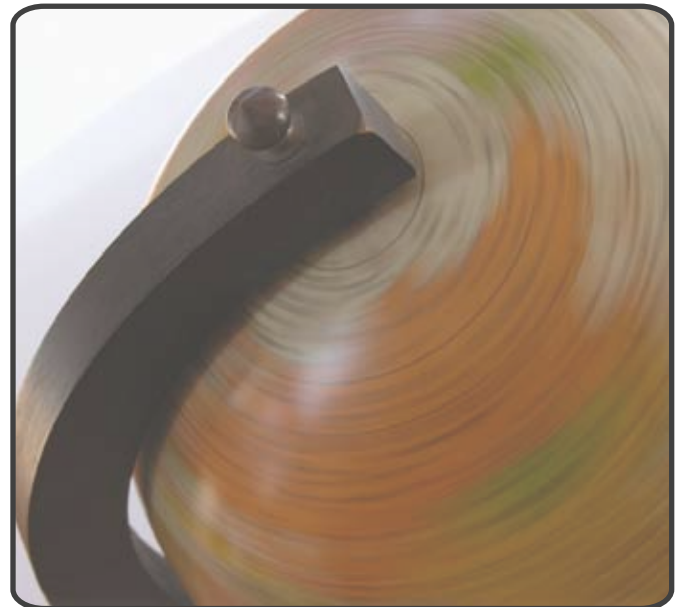


World Affairs
